

Interprovincials 2009.

Connacht wins 4 in a row.

Connacht continues to dominate the Interprovincials competition with yet another win on their home venue on River Shannon, Portumna, Co Galway.

The venue is self fish ok but was fairly peggy in places, there was some good catches of roach but there were also some good hybrids and the odd big bream showed up.

Day 1 saw Connacht take a good lead with 7 section wins giving them 14 points, Munster had 1 section win on 21 points and Leinster had 2 section wins on 25 points.
