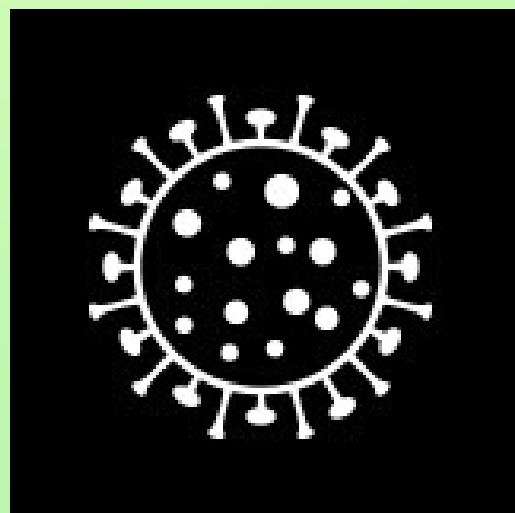




NCFFI Angling Road Map



2M SOCIAL DISTANCING MUST BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES

18th MAY

PHASE 1

Angling can take place in groups of up to four persons.

You may travel up to 5km from your home to fish

Boat anglers must always comply with social distancing and have consideration for hard surface disinfection.

Strictly No Contact

8th JUN

PHASE 2

Can fish with fellow club members in small groups.

Travel extended to 20km from your home

No competition, league, open or otherwise.

All activities to take place outdoors.

Strictly No Contact

29th JUN

PHASE 3

Can fish with fellow club members in small groups.

Maintain travel to within 20km of home

No competition, league, open or otherwise.

Your group may meet indoors at a venue supporting social distancing & cleansing.

Strictly no Contact

20th JUL

PHASE 4

Competition is permitted in accordance with the **NCFFI Covid Competition Protocol**.

This includes club leagues and open matches.

There are no restrictions on travel to take part.

Full Coaching can resume.

Strictly no Contact

10th AUG

PHASE 5

NCFFI Events and larger competitions may take place in accordance with **NCFFI Covid Competition Protocol**

Angling Festivals can resume in accordance with **NCFFI Festival Best Practise Guidelines**

Mass Gathering number restrictions (maximum 100) if any part takes place indoors, must be strictly adhered to

No Competition

- Do not share tackle or equipment
- Fish in places away from the general public where possible
- Avoid other groups
- Remember to observe social distancing when parking and at slipways
- Fish on stands/swims only at 15m intervals
- Do not allow others in your peg unless from the same household
- Check that the fishery is open and comply with all fishery rules
